Description

Antique Turkish Anatolian Oushak Rug with a salmon color background

Peach and orange works only on Oushaks. Three explicit columns of small lozenges and geometric flowers and palmettes organize the spaciouly drawn field of this west Anatolian carpet. The middle blue main border with a fringed arcading vine pattern descends from 16th century Ushak ancestors. In this decorative carpet, the field elements are big and abstract while the border is more delicate and curvilinear.
