

Antique Rug Studio

Late 19th Century Turkish Oushak Smyrna Carpet

Description

Three columns of characteristic Oushak palmettes alternate with two vertical lines of cruciform, hooked motives, all on an otherwise unornamented tomato red ground. A red rosette and Ottoman hyacinth border makes a traditional frame. Light green is widely used as an accent tone. This circa 1880 carpet is still in the traditional style with much earlier roots, before the neo-Persian trends of the late 19th century captured the market.
